NICK DRAKE'S SPIRIT RETURNS

Saturday 29 September – 7:30pm

The Old Eagle House Society is pleased to be hosting a concert, "The Songs of Nick Drake" performed by Keith James and Rick Foot. The duo have done over seven hundred performances and they will be touring the United States next year.

Nick's first boarding school was Eagle House which he called home for five years whilst his parents were living abroad. He was a talented character and achieved in many spheres including academia, sport and music. He left the school as head boy. Moving to Marlborough College as a scholar Nick became serious about his music and this continued during his short life. He was a top academic at Oxford University and graduated to pursue his music career. Depression set in when he found his style of music was not well received and sadly he allegedly took his own life at the age of 26. Like many talented artistes Nick's music continues to live and he has become quite an icon over the last ten years amongst the music fraternity.
