As you all know Santa will be in residence with a Christmas Carousel and steam train planned for the Malan Square. As well as all the craft activities we will be offering a selection of tasty refreshments and gifts will be available to purchase from some stalls. It is not like the normal cheap and cheerful child's Go Karts you often see about, I looked at numerous karts before deciding to purchase this one (The price new was £1599.00). Most of those I looked at seemed to be a bit of cheap tubing with an engine attached and a seat, whereas the X Cube looks like it is made for the job and includes full harness seatbelt, foam bar wraps and netting to keep the child safe at all times. This X Cube go kart would fit up to a tall 8 to 9 year old or a short 10 year old. Due to work commitments I wasn't able to take my son out to use this kart so it is basically like new. It has only had three tanks of petrol put through it so you can gauge how little it has been used!
