As you all know Santa will be in residence with a Christmas Carousel and steam train planned for the Malan Square. As well as all the craft activities we will be offering a selection of tasty refreshments and gifts will be available to purchase from some stalls. Entry to the event is free this year with a charge of £3.50 per child to visit Santa in his Grotto -advance tickets can be booked ahead allowing you to fast track on the day! An external organizer will be running a Ceramic Painting Activity at the Grotto and as spaces are limited tickets for this must be pre-paid and pre-booked. For a charge of £9.95 your child will be able to select an item to paint from a range of seasonal articles and they will be allocated a 45 minute painting slot within the 4 sittings that are being held.

All the children in Main School and Pre-Prep can take part in a Festive Art competition - needless to say the theme is "Christmas" and children can paint or create their piece of work in any medium as long as it can be hung on the wall as part of our display at the Grotto.
