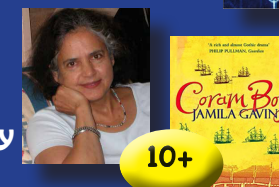

Friday 18 June 2010

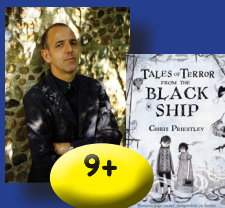
9.00 am **Nick Lake** visits us to talk about his latest novel Blood Ninja. Nick is a talented author and editor and will talk about his writing and what makes a good story
